## LEGAL STATEMENT

**This Mandate constitutes an official strategic and guiding instrument of Young African Leaders, Pioneers and Entrepreneurs (YALPAE).**

**It defines the organisation's purpose, institutional character, and strategic direction, and serves as the foundation for programme design, leadership development, and external engagement.**

**This Mandate shall be read together with the YALPAE Constitution, By-Laws, and all applicable governance instruments, and applies to all persons acting under YALPAE's authority or representation.**

## AUTHORITY CLAUSE

**This Mandate derives its authority from the YALPAE Constitution and is adopted to guide the organisation's strategic direction and implementation of its mission.**

- **The YALPAE Constitution**
- **The YALPAE By-Laws**
- **All applicable Annexes and governance instruments**

**This Mandate does not establish governance powers, legal obligations, or disciplinary authority, but provides strategic direction and institutional alignment across all YALPAE structures and activities.**

**In the event of any inconsistency:**

- **The Constitution shall prevail**
- **The By-Laws shall govern operational matters**
- **This Mandate shall guide interpretation and strategic intent**

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# YALPAE Mandate

## Building a Capable, Conscious, and Responsible Generation of African Youth

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### Chapter 1: Who YALPAE Is

#### 1.1 Organisational Identity

Young African Leaders, Pioneers and Entrepreneurs (YALPAE) is a youth-led, non-profit Pan-African organisation established to prepare, orient, and mobilise African youth to actively shape their societies, economies, and governance structures today.

YALPAE exists on the principle that **youth leadership is not a future event, but a present responsibility**. The organisation is governed and driven by young people, grounded in African identity, and committed to disciplined action, ethical leadership, and measurable community impact.

YALPAE operates in accordance with its Constitution and all applicable laws and policies and serves as a platform where African youth are not merely beneficiaries, but **actors, decision-makers, and custodians of their collective future**.

#### 1.2 Mandate Purpose

YALPAE's mandate is to:

- **Prepare youth early** with clarity, skills, values, and direction before cycles of exclusion, unemployment, and disengagement take root;
- **Build capable leadership**, not symbolic representation;
- **Restore African cultural grounding** as a source of confidence, identity, and responsibility;
- **Translate learning into action**, and action into sustainable outcomes;
- **Create continuity**, so youth development does not reset with every generation or leadership change.

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### Chapter 2: The Problem YALPAE Exists to Address

#### 2.1 Structural Exclusion and Misalignment

African youth face deep structural challenges including unemployment, weak school-to-work transitions, limited access to opportunity, and exclusion from decision-making spaces. Many interventions respond too late, after disempowerment has already taken hold.

YALPAE recognises that skills without orientation, and education without purpose, leave young people technically trained but strategically lost.

#### 2.2 Cultural Disconnection and Identity Erosion

A growing number of African youth are disconnected from their languages, histories, values, and collective memory. This erosion weakens confidence, belonging, and long-term social cohesion.

YALPAE treats culture not as performance, but as **infrastructure for leadership, ethics, and unity**.

## 2.3 Leadership Without Accountability

Youth are often invited to participate symbolically while real power remains elsewhere. This creates a culture of entitlement without responsibility, activism without continuity, and leadership without consequences.

YALPAE was founded to disrupt this pattern by **placing real responsibility, governance, and accountability in youth hands**, supported by clear systems and safeguards.

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## Chapter 3: YALPAE's Strategic Response

YALPAE responds through an integrated, youth-led model that combines:

### 3.1 Early Orientation & Capability Building

YALPAE designs programs that help young people identify their strengths, interests, and viable pathways across education, entrepreneurship, civic leadership, creative industries, agriculture, and emerging sectors early in their development.

The focus is not exposure alone, but **decision-making competence and follow-through**.

### 3.2 Leadership, Governance & Civic Responsibility

YALPAE develops youth leaders who understand governance, economics, public institutions, and ethical power. Youth are trained not only to critique systems, but to **operate, reform, and steward them responsibly**.

Leadership is treated as service, duty, and accountability.

### 3.3 Economic Participation & Enterprise

Through entrepreneurship support, skills development, and economic inclusion initiatives, YALPAE enables youth to build livelihoods, enterprises, and community-based economic solutions that reduce dependency and strengthen resilience.

### 3.4 Culture, Identity & African Consciousness

YALPAE integrates African history, languages, arts, and narratives into all programs to cultivate pride, self-knowledge, and unity across borders.

Cultural grounding is positioned as a foundation for ethical leadership, innovation, and Pan-African collaboration.

### 3.5 Structured Support, Safeguarding & Continuity

YALPAE operates through structured chapters, mentorship systems, and safeguarding frameworks to ensure that youth development is safe, consistent, measurable, and sustained beyond individual personalities or terms of office.

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## Chapter 4: Institutional Character

YALPAE is:

- **Youth-led**, not youth-branded
- **African-rooted**, not externally defined
- **Action-oriented**, not performative
- **Accountability-driven**, not personality-driven
- **Built for continuity**, not momentary relevance

The organisation measures success not by visibility alone, but by **capable youth, functioning structures, ethical leadership, and real community outcomes**.

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## Chapter 5: Mandate Authority

This Mandate derives its authority from and must be read together with the YALPAE Constitution. It guides strategic direction, program design, partnerships, and external representation, and may only be amended in a manner consistent with YALPAE's founding vision, mission, and values.
